This is our classroom and cloakroom.

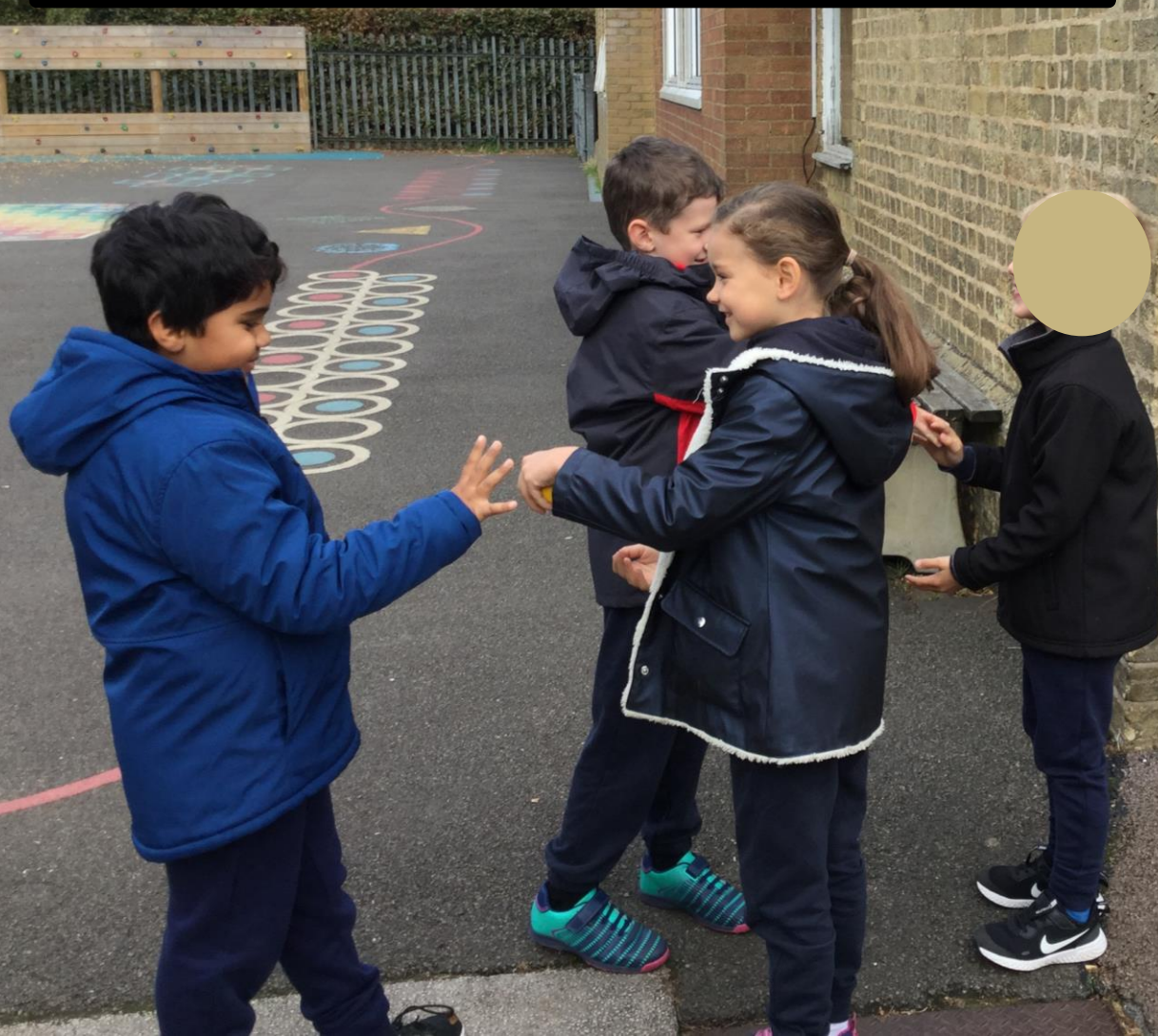


This is the back playground. We can play here and we also use it for learning games and P.E.

At playtime, we play with our friends and have fruit from the snack box.





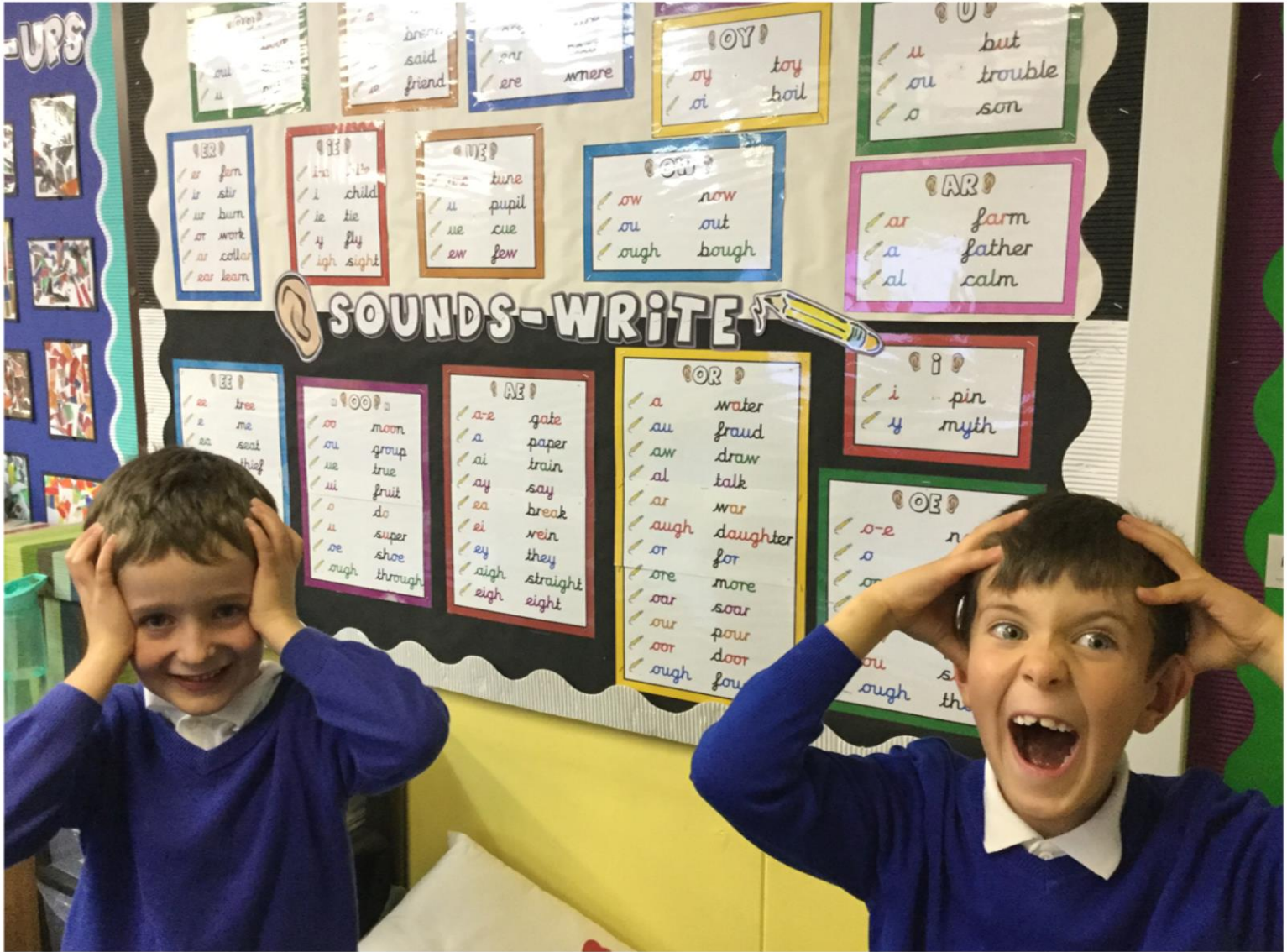


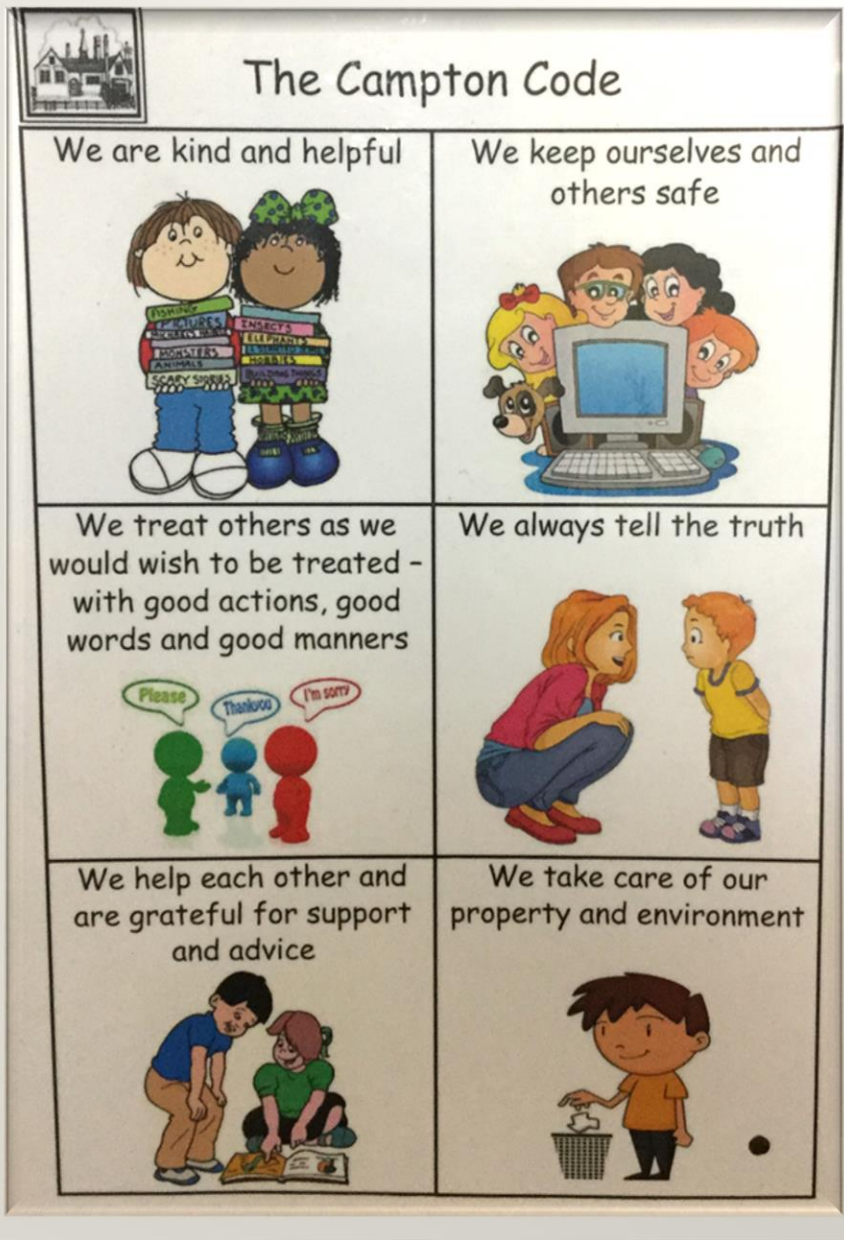
These are the Year 2 Common Exception words that we should be able to read and spell by the end of the year...

We post them in the right tube in the hall at lunchtimes.

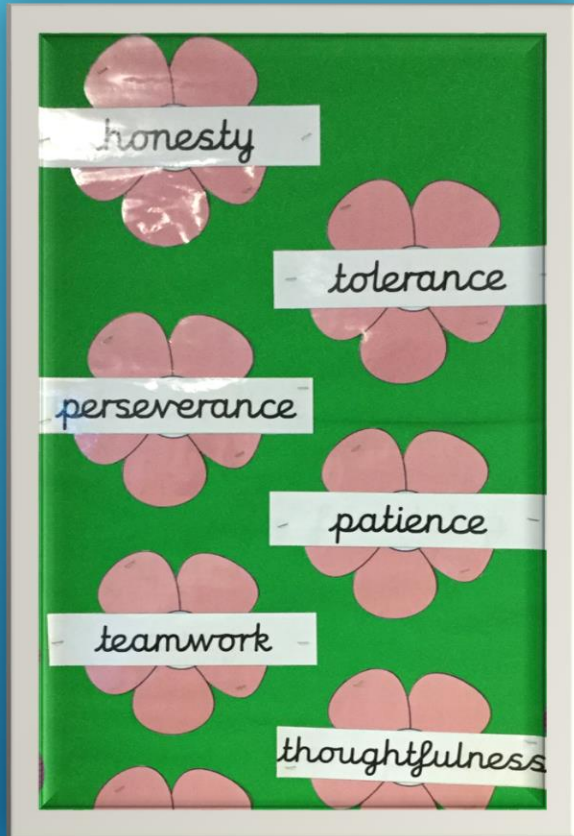


These are our

pencil cases.

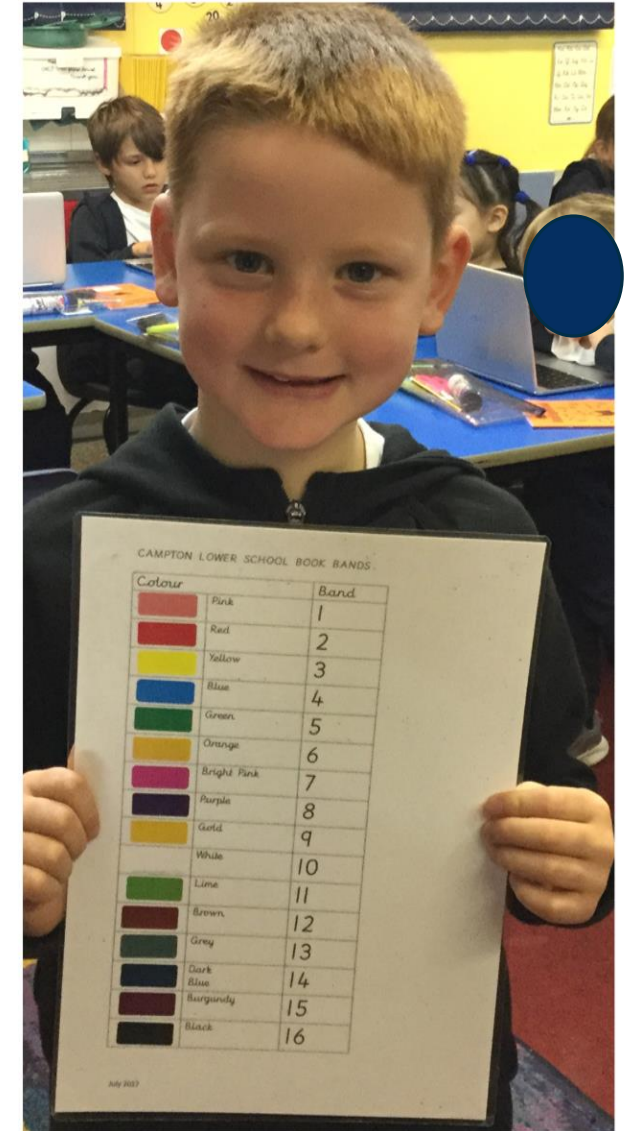


We love reading in Year 2! We have lots of books to read in the classroom, listen to lots of stories being read and we get stickers on our bookmarks for every time we read at home.



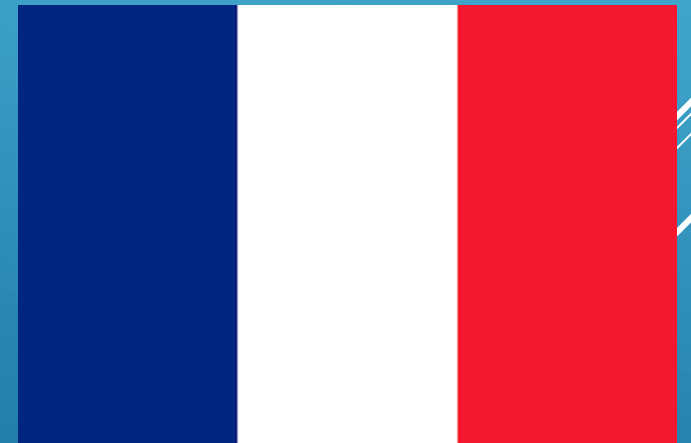
When we finish our reading books, we can change them ourselves in Year 2. We just pick a book we like from the right colour band box.

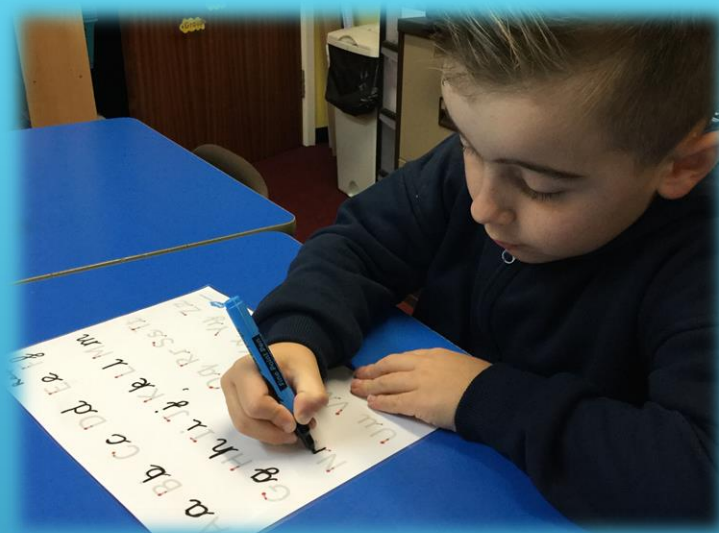
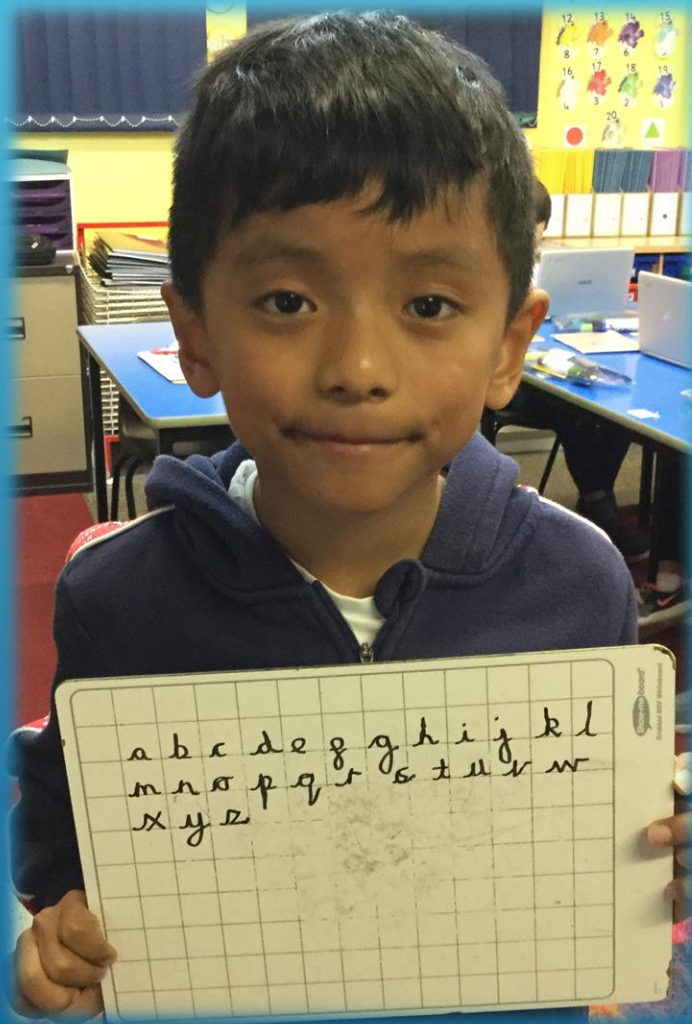
When we're ready, we then move up to the next colour band. In Year 2, we aim to be on White or Lime level by the end of the year.



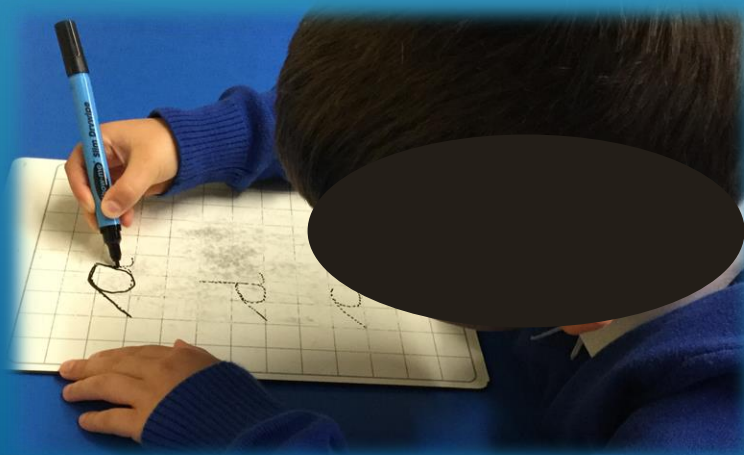


Camembear helps us to learn







She was born in America on the 4th February 1913.

We have Chrome Books in school that we use for our Computing lessons.

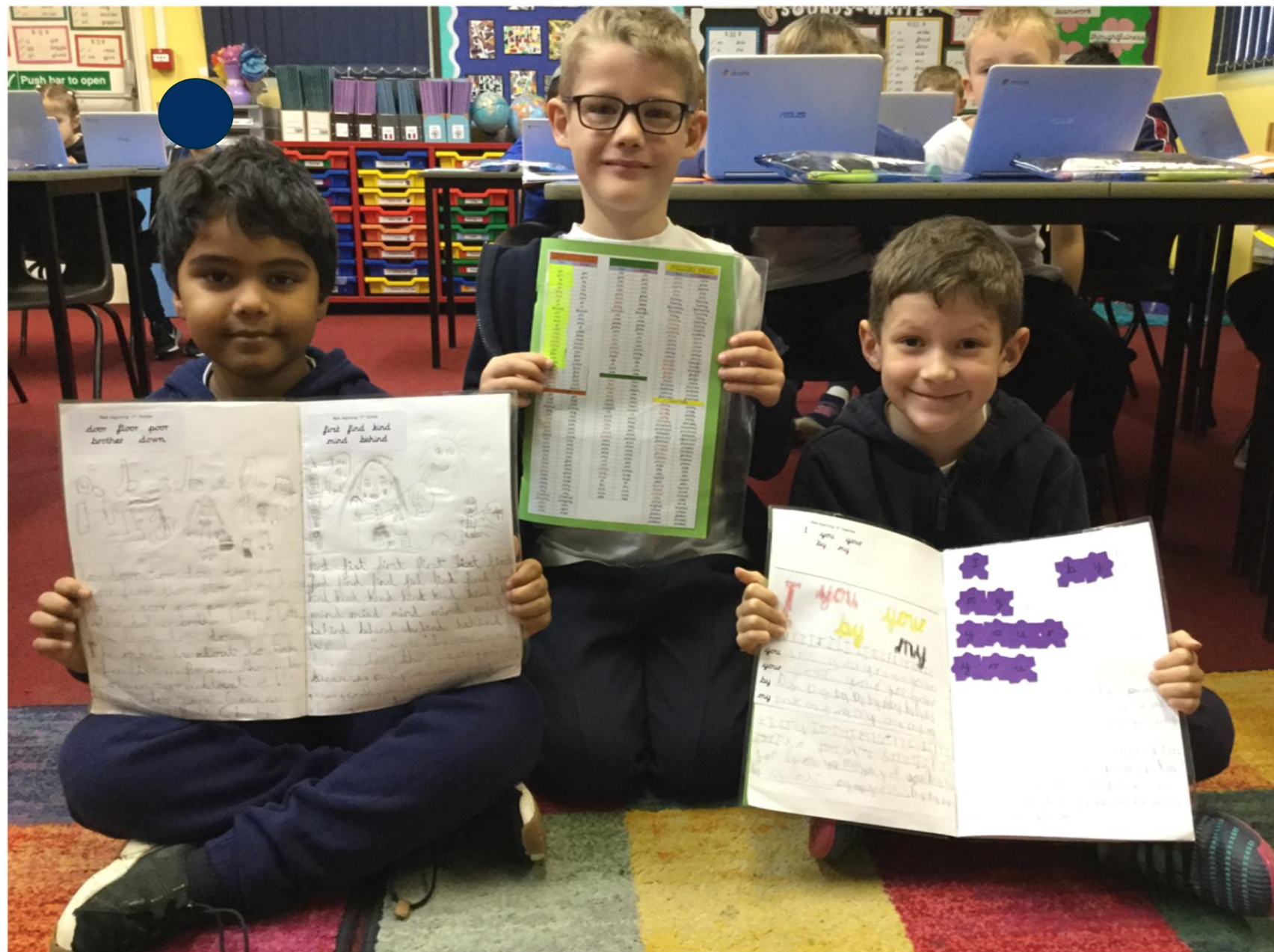


We all have Purple Mash and NumBots logins, which are inside our reading records. We can log onto from home too.
