Spring: European Artists - Learning to draw broken buildings, paint from underneath, create abstract 'cut-ups', make shape houses and draw with a rubber. Key Artists: Kiefer, Michelangelo, Dali, Rembrandt, Le Corbusier & Stella Jean

Autumn: Autumn - Creating 'Autumn' themed work using pencil, colour, print, collage and paper. Key Artists: Matisse, Cézanne, Pollock, Constable, Cole & Monet



Summer: Insects - Using pencil, colour, mosaic design, silhouettes, shadow puppets and sculpture to create work around the theme of 'insects'. Key Artists: Bourgeois, Angus & Kara Walker

Spring: British Art - Learning to use a range of media for making portraits. Key Artists: Gainsborough, Freud, Hodgkin, Kapoor, Rego & Boyce

Summer: Dragon Art - Studying a range of Chinese artwork. Developing sketching and drawing skills, building on previous knowledge of colour mixing when painting and creating dragon sculptures.



Autumn: Colour Chaos - Learning to recognise, choose, use & mix primary, secondary and tertiary colours, as well as tints and shades. Learning about abstract art and creating their own pieces, mainly in paint. Key Artists: Mondrian, Klee, Pollock, Delaunay, Kandinsky & Alma Thomas

Spring: Landscapes & Cityscapes - Learning about the bright colours and bold brushstrokes used by the Impressionists. Key Artists: Monet, Van Gogh & Metzinger

Autumn: Portraits - Learning about portraits, and use of different materials and techniques when making their own. Key Artists: Picasso, Klee, Matisse, Warhol & Basquiat.


