
<u>Cursive Handwriting</u>

- Capital letters do not join to any other letter.
- Start each letter at the top (see formation guidance on reverse).



- Lower case letters start from the line with a lead in.
- Every letter joins to the next apart from the letter x.



 As each lower case letter begins with a lead in, joining is a natural progression:

Campton ==> Campton

 Notice the letter o ends differently. This letter joins to the next with a horizontal line:

Campton

The same rule applies to the letters r, v and w:

rabbit vole weasel

Letter Formation

ABCDEFCHIJKLN Nopobstuvwxyz

 Left-handed writers would follow the same formation order as above however horizontal lines (letters in blue) can be drawn from right to left for example:



abcdefghijklm nopqrsturwryz
