

#### After-school pick-up arrangements

#### Names

#### School Lunch money (Years 3 & 4)

#### Coats

Please ensure your child always has a coat/rain jacket with them every day in school. As you know, our weather is extremely changeable and we don't want children to feel cold when they are in the playground.

#### Milk
