Warm Weather Procedures

<u>Hats and Water Bottles</u> - Please bring in <u>named</u> sun hats and water bottles every day during the Summer Term.

School Lunch money (Years 3 & 4)

Coats

Please ensure your child always has a coat/rain jacket with them every day in school. As you know, our weather is extremely changeable and we don't want children to feel cold when they are in the playground.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a named water bottle in school every day, **it should only contain water.**

Milk

Every child who is under the age of 5 is entitled to free milk in school. Once your child has turned 5, you have the option of paying for them to have milk in school.
